



## IANTD DIVER ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDE

Dear IANTD Diver,

Thank you for choosing IANTD as your certifier agency. So you can be prepared and understand the entire administrative process of your diving course, we have prepared this guide especially for you.

- Your IANTD instructor will have you complete some forms at various stages during your training course as follows:
  - The Initial Phase (before starting any activity):
    - Student Record Folder Form;  
This form provides your instructor with your personal contact information as well as the information needed to register you upon completion of your IANTD course.
    - The Medical Questionnaire Form;  
This form will help your instructor to be aware of any possible medical conditions and may also require you to visit your physician, if necessary.
    - Liability Release Form;  
This form will help you understand the risks related to the activities you are participating in during the course.
  - During the Confined Water classes and Open Water dives:
    - The Watermanship Form - first part:
      - With this form your instructor will grade each dive made and the various skills that will be conducted during your dive training. Your Instructor will explain the grades you earned and what you need to do to improve your skills during the next dive.
      - The value of the grades varies from 0 to 100, and the grades will help you track the progress of your dives in both confined water and open water or overhead environments.
      - What is the standard that your instructor will use to grade your performance?
        - The watermanship form is to be scored from 0% to a 100% scale in accordance with the following:
          - 00 to 49% additional confined water training is required prior to proceeding in the course.
          - 50 to 69% needs additional improvement. The average watermanship scores must go up.
          - 70 to 79% Marginal performance qualification withheld until performance improved.
          - 80 to 89% Good watermanship skills smooth and consistent.
          - 90 to 99% Exceptional watermanship skills.
          - Note! To be eligible for any IANTD training qualification, a minimum watermanship skill performance average must be 80% out of 100%. With additional dives, the student may graduate from the course with at least 80% on two consecutive dives. This may require several additional dives be added to the course.

  - Upon completion of the course:
    - The Watermanship Form - second part.
      - By completing the second part of Watermanship Form, your instructor confirms that you are certified or defines what additional items are required prior to earning your certification.
